You must join the <u>Google Classroom for the Summer Assignment</u>. All of the summer homework outlined in this document can be found in Google Classroom, where you will find "suggested" deadlines assigned to each piece of work that will appear in your calendar. The dates are **suggestions** (not requirements) and their express purpose is to help you manage your summer work. The alternative is that you race to finish everything during the final days of summer. That sounds stressful, doesn't it? As we will learn in class, the neurochemistry of stress significantly inhibits learning and long-term memory, which are exactly the things you want to enhance while preparing for the AP exam. So please consider my invitation to make progress following the suggested deadlines in Google Classroom.

The summer assignment consists of multiple components: videos and readings to review and take notes, small activities and quizzes to check understanding, a packet to help you start **memorizing** <u>chemical structures</u> that you will need to be familiar with for this course, and an exam during the first week of class. The asynchronous part of the Summer Assignment will take less than 10 hours total to complete, but you will be more effective in your learning of the material if you spread out your work.
