At ASFG, we strive to instill a love of literature and an appreciation for the pleasures of reading. Students who read independently dramatically improve their vocabulary, comprehension, and fluency.

Summer reading is the bridge that enables students to cross from one school year to the next with their learning intact. Students who do not read invariably lose some of the academic gains they made throughout the previous school year.

For these reasons we both expect and require every student at ASFG to read at least one grade-level appropriate book in English over the summer.

Each returning ASFG student should complete and submit the [Summer Reading Form](#) as early in the summer as possible. The form simply asks each student to declare the title and author of the book she or he intends to read over the summer (or, for later submissions, the book she or he read over the summer). Students should bring the book(s) they read over the summer to their first English class in August.
